Murphy Feud Live! at Murphy Maize Days - Game Show Rules

Overview:

Join us for *Murphy Feud Live!* — a high-energy, interactive game show experience inspired by the classic TV favorite, Family Feud. Team up with friends or family, guess the most popular survey answers, and compete for bragging rights and a grand prize!

Team Format:

- Teams consist of 5 players | Participants must be 13 or older, with at least 2 adults (18+) required per team.
- Teams must apply in advance and be selected by the Special Events Team
- No substitutions once gameplay begins

Game Structure:

- Round 1: Team A vs. Team B → Winner advances
- Round 2: Winner of Match 1 vs. Team C → Winner advances
- Round 3 (Final Round): Winner of Match 2 vs. Team D → Team with most wins or last winning team plays Fast Money

Gameplay Rules:

Round 1-3: Face-Off Rounds

- Each round begins with one player from each team at the podium.
- The host reads a survey question (e.g., "Name something you do before going to bed").
- First to buzz in gives an answer. If it's the top answer, their team may choose to play or pass.
- If not the top answer, the other team may guess to try and take control.
- The playing team then tries to reveal all the top answers (typically 4–8).
- Each incorrect answer results in a strike. 3 strikes and the opposing team gets a chance to steal by providing one correct remaining answer.
- Points are rewarded based on the total value of answers revealed.
- After 3 questions, the team with the most points wins the match and advances to face a new team.

Fast Money Round (Finale):

- The final winning team selects 2 players for Fast Money.
- Player 1 answers 5 questions in 20 seconds.
- Player 2 answers the same 5 questions in 25 seconds (no duplicate answers).
- If their combined score is 200 points or more, they win the Fast Money prize!

Other Rules:

- All decisions by the host are final.
- No outside help (phones, audience assistance, etc.) is allowed.
- This is a family-friendly game appropriate behavior and answers are expected.

Inappropriate answers/behavior may result in point deduction or disqualification.
